


## Long-term goals








## Course dashboard

A guided, consistent, and intuitive experience

Redesign Content as a course dashboard or hub

Retain traditional homepage navigation for past courses and clients who do not wish to change








### Getting started checklist

A minimal guide or checklist that walks instructors through setting up a course



## Control panel

(Edit course improvements)

Organize Edit Course around key tasks or workflows related to managing course utilities

Rename Edit Course so it is clear that it is an area for properties/settings/advanced features and not for lesson planning or activity creation (considering Control Panel)







#### Improved help

Introduce dismissible help bubbles for communicating new or updated features and functionality

Provide entry-points to external documentation site that can be overwritten by the organization

Improve tool and page level help

Review language/jargon with instructional design community

Can easily update dates for course materials

Integrate new copy/import tool in key course dashboard workflows – **CORE** 

Improve dates management workflows – **CORE** 

Improve discoverability of drag and drop features – UXP



## Integrate new copy/import tool

Include import/copy course components as a primary task in the Getting Started checklist

Embed new import/copy tool in dashboard workflows, most likely Table of Contents area






## Drag and Drop Improvements

Clear indication of drop target areas

Improved interactions when reordering modules

Smoother experience when dragging and dropping a lot of topics and modules

Simplify management of group discussions - C&C

Improve workflow for creating and managing group spaces – C&C

Improve workflow for group learning activities – FOUNDATIONS, C&C, CORE

Improve workflow for managing restrictions and release conditions – **CORE** 



#### Role Switch and Impersonation




